



WINTER ADVENTURE IN AUSTRIA'S LARGEST NATIONAL PARK – THE NATIONAL PARK HOHE TAUERN

The National Park Hohe Tauern is the biggest internationally recognized protected area of the Alps. The wilderness of the Hohe Tauern offers unique possibilities to experience Austria's winter away from busy and hectic ski slopes. A skilled team of park rangers will guide you, offering insights into the nature and beauty of our park.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Minimum number of participants for snowshoe excursions is 4 persons. For the wildlife watching in Habach 8 people need to attend the tour. The fee includes the costs for your guide as well as the rental of your snowshoes. Children from the age of 10 years upwards can attend snowshoe excursions.

Please remark that dogs can not be taken along to guided National Park excursions – with regard to the other participants and the domestic wildlife.

Excursions which are reachable by public transport are marked.

Please bring **good and sturdy shoes** as well as **warm clothing** (including hat and gloves), sun glasses as well as a **snack and something warm to drink**.

The park administration reserves the right to cancel excursions in case of bad weather conditions or the risk of avalanches.

THE TOURS ARE RATED BETWEEN EASY, MEDIUM AND CHALLENGING.

Easy: These excursions are heading through gentle terrains and the time spent walking is not as long as on the other tours.

Medium: The terrain is more difficult and/or the walking time is longer. These trips require a higher level of fitness.

Challenging: These excursions require a sound level of fitness as walking time is over 3 hours and the terrain is steeper.

A cancellation of participation for the tours is possible until the day before the tour at 10:00 a.m. and for the Sunday tour on Friday at 10:00 a.m. at the park administration. In case of a late cancellation the park administration reserves the right to charge participants not showing up or cancelling late 100% of the participation fee.

Special rates:

The snowshoe excursions (not including the 2-day trip into the Krimmler Achental as well as the alpine ski tours and the spring programme) **are free of charge for visitors of the Holiday Region National Park Hohe Tauern. Expenses for transport (e.g. taxi, snowmobile) or toboggan rental have to be paid separately.**

TUESDAY AND THURSDAY



Mountain deer in winter – Wildlife watching in the Habach valley, Bramberg

During the cold and snowy months the red deer of the Hohe Tauern do not find enough food in the mountain forests. In former times, the red deer packs used to move into the lower regions of the Salzach floodplains where enough fodder was available. Due to growing settlements, roads, train tracks and intensified usage of the floodplains for agriculture during the last century, this winter migration is no longer possible for the animals.

During this excursion you will find out that feeding stations can be managed in various ways and how these stations are an integral part of the

active wildlife management of the park. Of course it is also an excellent opportunity for wildlife watching and an exciting excursion for the whole family!

Guided tour through the Nationalpark Gallery

The "Cinema 3000" is your entrance to the Nationalpark Gallery – it awaits you with breathtaking and unlimited views of the nature around the Kitzsteinhorn peak.

Afterwards you will dive into the mystic inner world of the mountain. A 360 meter mine shaft goes through the Kitzsteinhorn peak with many exciting info stations (emergence of the Hohe Tauern mountain chain, permafrost ...).

At the end an impressive panorama platform is waiting.

Without needing any climbing skills you are right at eye level with the Grossglockner peak and the highest mountains in Austria – ideal for enjoying the magnificent peak and sublime peace of the Hohe Tauern National Park.

TUESDAY



Wasenmoos - majestic views of the mountain chain and insights into the Hohe Tauern National Park

An easy snowshoe excursion through the soft and rolling landscape of the Wasenmoos, high above Mittersill enables you to sense the mightiness of the Hohe Tauern mountain chain. The National Park ranger gives you insights into this unique living environment, which often appears ominous and inaccessible in winter.

Place: Mittersill

Dates: Every Tuesday from 20th of December 2011 to the 20th of March 2012

Meeting point: 12:30 noon at the parking lot of Gasthof Tauernblick (estimated time of return: 4.30 p.m.)

With snowshoes in the Hüttschlag valley, Großarl/Hüttschlag

Explore the calm valley far away from the hustle and bustle of the ski slopes together with a National Park ranger. Depending on the snow conditions we hike along the "Großarler Ache" (river) or towards the Ötzhütte.

Afterwards there is time to visit the exhibition "Secrets of the mountain forest" or finish the day with a hot cup of tea in the Talwirt (inn).

Waterfalls in winter

The waterfalls in Krimml are an impressive natural spectacle, not only in summer. Through their location on the shady side only a few rays of sun reach them in winter. Due to this phenomenon remarkable ice formations develop within the winter months.

This snowshoe excursion leads from the railway station in Krimml to the waterfalls and offers very special impressions of the Hohe Tauern in winter. You get back from the "WaterWonderWorld" to the railway station in Krimml by using public bus.

Magical Hüttwinkl valley – Rauris

Trees and hillsides deeply snowed under the Hüttwinkl Valley lends itself ideally to explore this part of the Rauriser Valley with snowshoes.

Grand views to the Sonnblick and the Ritterkopf are just as much to enjoy as the possibility to view some of the local wildlife – of course with some luck.

Winter excursion into the Hollersbach valley

Along the Hollersbach creek winter often shows itself from its most beautiful sides. Due to the close creek, trees are often covered in glittering crystals of white frost which form bizarre shapes.

"Platte" – Small peak but great view

We walk through the deeply snow-covered forest "Lachwald" in the direction of the Pölsenalm.

Tracks of domestic animals like mountain hares or mountain cocks are not uncommon in this ethnic landscape. After 2,5 hours we reach the "Platte" with its unique panoramic view.

Hirschgruben forest – on the nature's track

This snowshoe excursion leads you via meadows and forest into the direction of the Hirschgrubenalm (mountain hut). The Hirschgruben forest lets you discover lots of tracks of wild animals which use this beautiful area as their living environment.

Ethnic Sulzbach valleys

Winter converts the Obersulzbach valley and the Untersulzbach valley at the foot of the Großvenediger into a mystic landscape. You will discover this area with its ethnic forests and icy waterways together with a National Park ranger.

At the foot of the Sonnblick – snowshoe hiking in Kolm Saigurn

A beautiful tour nearby the primeval forest of Rauris, right into the direction of the Durchgangsalm (mountain hut).

You will walk along old Swiss stone pines and spruces guided by a National Park ranger.

As time permits there will be a short break to have a cup of tea or hot chocolate at the Naturfreunde-haus in Kolm Saigurn, at the foot of the Sonnblick and the impressive peaks of the Goldberg mountain chain.

Impressive Fusch

The Fusch valley is one of the steepest valleys within the Eastern Alps. The peaks of Tenn, Wiesbachhorn and other 3.000 meter high mountains are assembled on minimal space and offer a sight to behold. During this snowshoe excursion you walk along the lonesome Weichselbach valley right into the direction of Bad Fusch.

Place: Fusch

Dates: Every Friday from the 23rd of December 2011 to the 28th of March 2012

Meeting point: 9:20 a.m. at the Embach chapel (estimated time of return 3.00 p.m.)

Costs: € 11,- per person (adult), € 8,- for children (from 10-14 years). Costs for possible shuttle service for the return from Bad Fusch to the Embach chapel extra (if snow conditions are bad)

Alpine Stubach valley

A snowshoe excursion in the backmost Stubach valley. You will discover lots of different tracks of animals and get to know how the animals in the mountains struggle for survival within the winter in their living space Hohe Tauern National Park.

You will use the cable car Weißseebahn to get up to the middle station. From there the excursion leads you through unspoilt nature into the direction of the Niedere Scharte.

Dreamy Kolm Saigurn

With a Park Ranger you head off from Bodenhaus in Rauris towards Durchgangsalm and the traditional stone house of the Ammererhof. This is for sure one of the most beautiful snowshoe excursions in the region Pinzgau.

After the hike there is time to enjoy a hot chocolate or traditional Austrian cuisine in the Ammererhof before you head back to the Bodenhaus with a toboggan or a snowmobile.

EXHIBITIONS AND INFORMATION CENTERS



National Park Worlds Mittersill

The center is the ideal start for a visit to the park. In eight “worlds” visitors get an insight view into the largest National Park of the Alps and the life of its inhabitants. The topics span from the geological forming of the Alps in the 3D-cinema to a man-sized marmot dam, the world of glaciers and much more.

Kings of the Skies Rauris, Wörth

Find out more about Bearded Vultures, Griffon Vultures and Golden Eagles. They are the biggest birds in the Alps and an important species in the ecological balance of the Hohe Tauern.

Emeralds & Crystals Museum Bramberg, Bramberg

This exhibition resembles a true treasure box. Since manhood has settled in the area the Hohe Tauern range has been famous for its beautiful and rare crystals. Extraordinary pieces are presented here. The same building also hosts a folkloric museum.

Opening hours: 26th of December 2011 to the 31st of December 2011 daily from 1 to 5 p.m., 3rd of January 2012 to the 7th of April 2012 every Tuesday & Friday from 1 to 5 p.m.

Entrance: € 5,- per person (adults), € 3,- for kids between 6 and 15 years

Guided tours are available on demand (€ 25,- for groups up to 25 people)



Aquatic living Fusch, wildlife park Ferleiten

This exhibition opened in summer 2011. It shows life within the lakes and brooks of the National Park. You get to know more about the fascinating adaptation strategies of, e.g. autochthon brown trouts or minnows, to their living space in the high mountains.

Opening hours: Beginning of May to end of October 2012

Secrets of the mountain forest

Hüttschlag in Großarl valley, Talwirt

In a mountain forest many things are to be discovered – do some trees need a fungus to survive? Can a nutcracker be without a swiss stone pine? In an interactive way the exhibition invites you to discover some of these secrets yourself.

Opening hours: 25th of December 2011 to 8th of January 2012 daily between 11 a.m. and 9 p.m.

9th of January to 18th of March 2012 daily between 11 a.m. and 9 p.m. – closed on Mondays

Tauernwege

Mittersill, Felberturm museum

The mountain chain of the Hohe Tauern has always been a barrier that needed to be crossed in order to deliver goods from north to south and vice versa. This exhibition shows you more about the life of the former carriers and forwarders.

Opening hours: May and October 2012: Saturday, Sunday and official holiday: 1-5 p.m. June to September 2012: Tuesday-Friday: 10 a.m.-5 p.m., Saturday, Sunday and official holiday: 1-5 p.m. Closed on Mondays.

Nationalpark Gallery

Kaprun, Kitzsteinhorn

The "Cinema 3000" is your entrance to the Gallery, it shows you breathtaking views of the nature around the Kitzsteinhorn peak. Afterwards a 360 meter mine shaft leads you through the Kitzsteinhorn peak with many exciting info stations. At the end an impressive panorama platform is waiting.

That's how nature tastes (herb garden)

Hollersbach

The herb garden behind the old Klausnerhaus in Hollersbach offers you a wide range of medical plants, kitchen herbs and poisonous plants. Especially when participating in a guided tour through the garden you will get to know a lot about the usage of these plants and herbs.

2-day adventure in the Krimmler Achen valley

Experience a unique and special weekend in one of the most impressive valleys of the Hohe Tauern – The Krimmler Achen valley.

After the first exciting day a relaxing evening in a cosy lounge awaits you, as well as an overnight stay in the historic Krimmler Tauern house – one of the oldest lodges of the region. It is one of the old frontier lodges from which trades started their long and dangerous hikes over the mountain range into the South.

On the hike of the second day you will discover the spectacular western part of the National Park.

CUSTOMIZED TOURS



The National Park Administration offers a customized service for individual travellers who want to experience the Hohe Tauern on a private tour with one of the experienced park rangers.

Tours and details will be matched with your expectations and special interests/preferred activity. The maximum number of participants per group/per ranger varies depending on the sights/activities that you wish to see (upper limit is 20 people).

This service is bookable year round.

ALPINE SKI TOURS IN SPRING

From Heiligenblut to Kolm Saigurn, Rauris



This is a demanding alpine ski tour from the small Fleiß valley in Carinthia to the Rauriser Sonnblick (peak at 3.105 m). The summit will be reached at midday. After an extended rest at the Zittelhaus we start the downhill on the Salzburg side to Kolm Saigurn in Rauris with more than 1.500 m difference in altitude.

Date: 31st of March 2012

Meeting point: 5 a.m. in Mittersill at the parking lot of the National Park Worlds. Afterwards bus trip to Heiligenblut. The group will be picked up at Kolm Saigurn after the tour and brought back to Mittersill.

Costs: € 85,- per person, including transport

To sign up: Until Monday, 26th of March 2012, 12:00 noon.

Good physical condition (ascent: 1.300 m difference in altitude) and sound skiing skills are absolutely necessary.

This tour only takes place if snow conditions are safe and if the weather is good.

Crossing the Krimmler Tauern – on skis or snowshoes



This well-known passage from South Tyrol into the Krimmler Achen valley is something special on touring skis.

The ascent to the Krimmler Tauern (at 2.633 m) starts in Kasern in the Ahrn valley. At the early afternoon the descent into the Windbach valley starts and finally we reach the valley floor of the Krimmler Achen valley. A taxi brings us back from the Krimmler Tauernhaus to Krimml.

Dates: Snowshoe excursion: 6th of April 2012

Alpine ski tour: 7th of April 2012

Meeting point: 4:30 a.m. in Krimml, parking lot Wasser Wunder Welt

Costs: € 85,- per person, including transport

To sign up: Until Monday, 2nd of April 2012, 12:00 noon.

Good physical condition (ascent: 1.050 m difference in altitude) and for the alpine ski tour sound skiing skills in deep powder snow are absolutely necessary.

This tour only takes place if snow conditions are safe and if the weather is good.

From Hinterbichl to Neukirchen



A terrific alpine ski tour in between the mountains Großvenediger and Großer Geiger. A taxi brings the group from Hinterbichl backwards as far as possible into the direction of the Dorfer valley. Passing the Johannishütte (mountain hut) we go further northwards to the Obersulzbachtörl (at 2.918 m). The downhill follows with more than 1.200 m difference in altitude to the Postalm.

After a well-deserved break we continue the downhill to Neukirchen.
